Taiko (太鼓) originates from Japan and is played all over the world. Taiko has not only spread geographically over the years but has expanded artistically as well, from traditional festival drumming, to the creation of new styles of taiko and collaboration with other musical forms.

Kenny Endo

Kenny Endo is at the vanguard of the taiko genre, continuing to explore new possibilities for this ancient Japanese instrument. A performer, composer, teacher, Kenny is a consummate artist, blending taiko with original music through collaborations with

artists from around the world. In 2022, Kenny toured across the USA performing concerts, conducting workshops, and lectures. He recently received the Hompa Hongwanji Living Treasures of Hawaii Award. In January 2022, Kenny was awarded the United States Artists award. In 2023, Kenny toured in the US west coast, Canada, Scotland, Spain, Switzerland, UK, and Belgium. Workshop #1: Ji Patterns and Soloing Musically

One of taiko's major roles in traditional Japanese music is as an accompaniment for theater, dance, and other music genres. In *kumi daiko* the art of correctly propelling the music and supporting the soloists through solid *ji* playing (base beat) are often overlooked. Basic *kumi daiko ji* patterns as well as patterns from traditional music will be explained. We will practice the elements that go into making a musical and exciting improvised solo. Internalizing the beat, soloing within a group context, timing, and performing as a soloist will also be covered. Spontaneity, phrasing, and thematic soloing will be introduced. A great improvised solo will not only raise the energy level of performance but transport everyone to another place. Explore the creativity you have within yourself.

Workshop #2: Creativity and Composition

Where does one begin to create contemporary works in this new art form for an ancient instrument? Students will be introduced to some examples of traditional Japanese drumming patterns as well as some Western and patterns from around the world. This workshop will present several challenges to the participants as a way of unlocking their own creativity. In small group sessions, participants will share their varied talents and imagination as a means to cultivate ideas for simple themes. By arranging those creative thoughts or motives, and through feedback, new compositions will be born.
